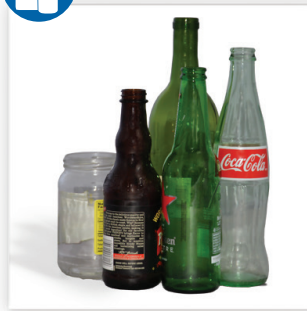
Aluminum, Steel, and Tin Cans
